FOREWORD

General Forsyth was a participant in many historically significant events. He took part in 16 pitched battles, 2 sieges, and at least 60 minor engagements of the Civil War, including the battles of Opequan and Middletown, Dixwiddle Court House, Five Forks, Fredericksburg, Chancellorsville, Spottsylvania, and Sailor's Creek. He accompanied General Sheridan on his famous ride from Winchester to Cedar Creek and was present at Appomatox Court House at the surrender of General Lee.

After the Civil War, he became a frontier Indian fighter, carrying out successful campaigns against the Arapaho, Sioux, Cheyenne, Kiowa, and Apache tribes in Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, and New Mexico. His most famous battle was that of Beecher Island.

After his retirement from the Army, he published his personal accounts of many of the noteworthy events in which he had been involved.

Provenance. The papers were accumulated by General George A. Forsyth and Mrs. Natalie S. B. Forsyth over the years 1861 to 1920.

They were presented to the State Historical Society in 1946 by a grand-niece of the General, Mrs. Benjamin A. Brackenbury, 1994 Midwick Drive, Altadena, California. There is no documentation as to restriction of use and it is therefore presumed that the collection is dedicated to the public domain.

The collection is accessioned with the number 26519 entered in the 1963-68 accession book of the Library, State Historical Society of Colorado.

The papers contain official and private correspondence, primarily incoming, 1865-1920; newspaper clippings of articles written by and about the General, including a number of death notices from various newspapers across the United States, 1873-1937; photographs of the General, Beecher Island, Sheridan and his staff, et al., 2x3 inches to 8x6 inches; military orders and reports, 1862-1890; manuscripts and printed articles written by and about the General, 1873-1915; invitations, programs, and other memorabilia.
