Incorporated in 1926, the Denver, Colorado Springs and Pueblo Motorway carried passengers, baggage, and express for hire between points in Colorado by motor vehicle. The company owned and operated garages for storage, repair, and care of vehicles. The company bought, sold, and traded vehicles, accessories, equipment and supplies.

The principal office of the Denver, Colorado Springs & Pueblo Motorway was in Denver. F. A. Peil became the company's first president in 1926, but was soon succeeded by F. E. James. Stockholders in the company included the Colorado & Southern Railway, the Greeley Transport Company, and the D & R G W as major shareholder.
